CURRICULUM

We aim to provide a broad and balanced curriculum for all our students. Working with the curriculum designed for community schools by the Ministry of Education of Cyprus and the Ministry of Education of Greece, our own curriculum includes cultural, religious, and historical topics relating to Greece, and Cyprus.

Our language targets have been specifically developed for each year group and are reviewed annually. This cross-curricular approach to teaching and learning also incorporates music, and dance; often, these provide the focus for our annual concerts and celebrations. Part of our curriculum includes class assemblies which form a vital part of each pupil's overall development and enrichment. They provide opportunities for team building, developing a sense of responsibility and citizenship as well as assisting in the development of oral/aural skills in the Greek language needed for a good grade at GCSE and A-level examinations. Therefore pupils are expected to attend and participate in each school celebration as part of their course work.
